Three speakers give updates on building projects in Cold Spring area

At the luncheon on Thursday, June 9, 2011 the attendees enjoyed a lite summer lunch catered by Assumption Dining and then were treated with updates from three speakers about various exciting building projects in Cold Spring.

The first to deliver the long awaited news about which grocery store would be moving into Granite Landing, the land made available by the vacating of Cold Spring Granite. Greg Carlson, manager of Teal's Market, announced that they'll be breaking ground at a ceremony on Monday at 10 am. The expected completion date is expected to be by mid-November and hopes to be fully operating by Thanksgiving with each department about 50% larger. There will be some additions, but for now the most obvious will be the increase of about 20 more employees and the overall size of the store, the rest of the changes will be gradual and after researching feasibility in the area.

Next to deliver an update on the expansion at Assumption Home is Tony Nathe who reported that phase five of the project will be completed sometime in July or August and that the front door has changed locations and the entry area is very spacious and inviting. There will be an on-campus store and will continue to offer a new program in Home Health Care. So far there is no date set yet for their Grand Re-opening.

Cold Spring's City Administrator, Paul Hetland was the next speaker to present updates on several city projects. First, Hetland congratulated Teal's Market for their long-awaited progress and then said regarding the vacating of Teal's is going to be a domino effect from area businesses taking over business locations, but no firm details are set yet, just 'wheels in motion.' Hetland also commented on the restoration and expansion project the Cold Spring Brewery is undergoing estimating a \$10 million budget. Another project on everyone's mind is the problem with Cty Rds. 2 & 50. At this point, Hetland reported there is the long-range plan of a possible round-a-bout in that are, but as with everything the cost of \$500-700,000 is the largest barrier, so its on the 'back burner' for now. Also a grant to the DNR has been submitted to purchase and develop some river's edge land running from Frogtown Park to Granite Landing for a nature center/historical museum. It was emphasized that all these plans are very much in the infancy stages and are dependent on a lot of factors all falling into place which will take time and coordination and will not be immediate.
